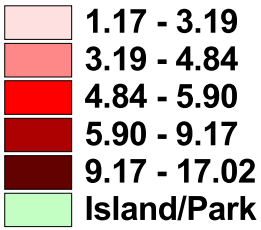


Asthma Hospitalization Rates by Neighborhood Children Aged 0-14, New York City, 2000

Rate Per 1,000



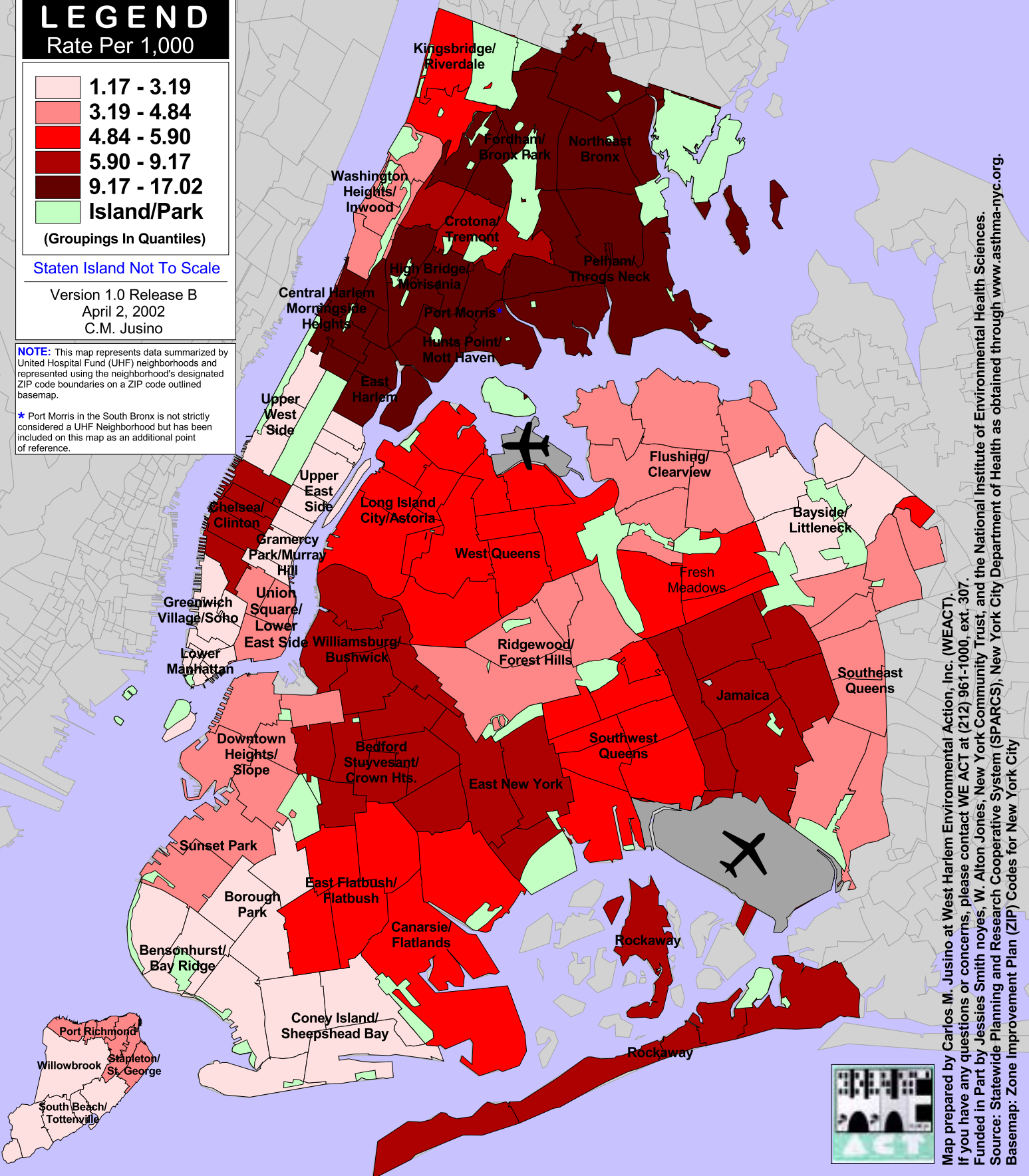
